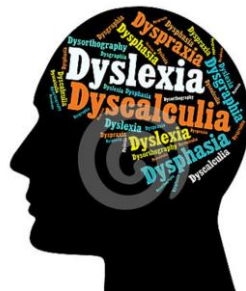

Commission & Literacy Agencies to Participate in Ex-Offender Expo

On **Tuesday, July 30th**, The Mayor's Commission on Literacy will participate in an Ex-Offender Expo spearheaded by The Mayor's Office of Reintegration Services for Ex-Offenders at the Pennsylvania Convention Center.

The Expo will feature more than **100 service providers** and up to **100 employers**, as well as workshops and resources to help returning citizens search for employment, prepare for interviews, and develop the skills necessary for a pathway to self-sufficiency.
